

DIRECTIONS TO THE CAMPSITE IN CALIFORNIA CITY FOR THE CODY WATERS BENEFIT RIDE

Basically there are two ways to get to the campsite from either Orange County or Los Angeles County. You will be given directions for both ways and you can choose what works best for you.

The first way to get there is to take either the 405 FWY or the 5 FWY north to the 14 FWY north. Stay on the 14 FWY until you arrive in the town of Mojave. As you enter the town of Mojave, the first signal light you come to is at the intersection of the 14 FWY and the Mojave/ Barstow highway. Turn right and stay on the Mojave / Barstow road for approximately 4.1 miles, until you can enter the 58 FWY going east. Stay on the 58 east for approximately 11 miles, then exit at California City Blvd. the exit will be on the left hand side as you are traveling east, so be sure to stay in the left lane, as there are very few signs to give you notice to the upcoming turn. After you turn left onto California City Blvd., drive about 3.9 miles and turn right onto the dirt road that will be marked with two orange cones and signs. Follow the signs for about 1.7 miles to the camp site. **Driving there this way is 10 miles shorter than taking the 15 FWY.**

The other way out to the campsite is to take the 15 FWY north to the 395 FWY north. Stay on the 395 FWY for about 42 miles and then take the 58 FWY west. Stay on the 58 FWY for about 22 miles and then turn right onto California City Blvd. After you turn right onto California City Blvd., drive about 3.9 miles and turn right onto the dirt road that will be marked with two orange cones and signs. Follow the signs for about 1.7 miles to the camp site.

GPS coordinates are N 35 degrees 04.052 W 117 degrees 53.341

After you arrive, please check in with someone at the registration desk to pick up your wristband and raffle tickets.

If you need gas, water or supplies, California City is only a few miles away and there is a Rite Aid, Ace hardware, Radio Shack and a Motorcycle store (High Desert Racing) in town if needed.

If you need water for your trailer before you arrive, there is a trailer park in Mojave that charges \$2 for water and \$5 to dump. There is easy access in and out and plenty of room for large trailers / motor homes. It is called Spaceport RV park (661-824-2811) and is at the intersection of Nadeau Street and "L" street, just 3 blocks behind the McDonalds which is on highway 14.
